**Police Report** - 67 reports of committed crimes, 27 have been detected and 31 are ongoing.

16 theft related crimes and only 1 drug related crime.

3 reports of vandalism with a number of named suspects.

There has been 13 reported assaults, 8 have been detected and 3 have named suspects with 2 remaining under enquiry.

No reports of drink/drug driving this month.

There has only been one anti-social behaviour fixed penalty ticket issued in the last month for urinating in a public place.
