GETTING IT RIGHT FOR EVERY CHILD

Named Person Information Leaflets for Parents and Carers

All parents/carers will receive a leaflet over the next month providing them with information about the Getting It Right for Every Child principles including the role of the Named Person. The leaflets also provide information about child protection.

There are four leaflets – birth, nursery, primary school and secondary school. They will be given to parents every year at point of transition to ensure parents/carers are aware of who to contact should their child need support.

All children in Moray will shortly receive their copy. The leaflets can be downloaded at :

Child's Plan / LIAP

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Work is on-going to develop a new integrated child's plan. It is proposed that the new plan will be modular so it can be added to as the child's needs change but it will include the Individual Education Plan and the Co-ordinated Support Plan.

But in the meantime continue to use the current child's plan and Local Integrated Assessment Process.

Measuring Outcomes in Moray

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It is easy to measure something when you can count it or see it but much harder when it's about how we feel.

Getting it right for every child means looking at how they are doing in terms of the 8 wellbeing indicators

Safe ~ Healthy ~ Achieving ~ Nurtured Active ~ Respected ~ Responsible Included

It's not an exact science as it is often about how they or the parent/ carers thinks and feels they are doing. We can start to measure how they are doing though by using the

Wellbeing Web to plot where they feel they are at different points in time.

The web can be used with all children including those with learning difficulties.
