2. LIST OF DECISIONS FOR APPLICATIONS FOR PREMISES LICENCES

(i) Application for a New Premises Licence at Speyburn Distillery, Rothes, Aberlour, AB38 7AG

The Depute Clerk introduced the application and advised the applicant had been cited to the meeting. Neil Ross, solicitor represented the applicant. The Depute Clerk advised that all paperwork was in order. The premises had been site visited. After hearing from Neil Ross the Board agreed to grant the licence.

(ii) Application for a Variation to Premises Licence Crown and Anchor, 44 Findhorn, Findhorn, IV36 3YF

The Depute Clerk introduced the application and advised the applicant was represented by Niall Hassard, solicitor. The Licensing Board had been out to site visit. The Depute Clerk advised that all paperwork was in order and that there were no objections or representations.

(iii) Application for a Variation to Premises Licence the Whisky Castle and Highland Market, 6 Main Street, Tomintoul, AB37 9EX
