#### Received from Police Scotland

The dedicated number for the Police IRD Desk is to arrange IRDs.

Any incidents involving crime, or likely to involve crime, should be reported to Police using the telephone number 101 in the first instance.

The Police single point of contact for Inter Agency Referral Discussion (also known as Initial Referral Discussions) (IRD) is the Police IRD Desk, which is based at Bucksburn Police Office and comes under the wing of the Public Protection Unit (PPU). The Desk is staffed by experienced DSs who provide a consistent approach to the Police involvement in IRDs.

The Police IRD Desk is staffed

Monday to Friday 7am to 5pm, and 7am to 3pm at the weekends.

The Police Officers who will carry out IRDs out with these hours are as follows -

Monday to Friday 5pm to 10pm - Duty PPU Detective Sergeant

Monday to Friday 10pm to 7am, and Saturday/Sunday 3pm to 7am - Suitably experienced supervisor nominated by the Duty Inspector (City or Landward)

CPT PS = Community Policing Team Police Sergeant (Divisional Sergeant)

Contact can be made with the Police IRD Desk on telephone number 01224 306918. If for any reason there is no response at this number, please try again or revert to Police Scotland's 101 number and ask to be transferred to the Police IRD Desk, the PPU Detective Sergeant, or the Duty Inspector, whichever is most appropriate given the above times.

The PPU DSs and the CPT PSs should initially be contacted on 101.

It is recognised that overnight, IRDs may only deal with immediate risk and further discussion may need to be progressed the following morning. A telephone conference line has been set up to facilitate IRDs. The telephone number and PIN will be notified by the Police IRD Desk when required.
