



MORAY & NAIRN EDUCATIONAL TRUST SCHEME 1935

CONDITIONS OF AWARD OF GRANT

1. Under the above-mentioned Scheme, the Moray Council has powers to make grants for various purposes, details of which are given in Para. 4 below:-
2. Grants can normally be made only to -
 - persons resident in the former combined County of Moray and Nairn,
 - school pupils or young persons attending Moray or Nairn schools or further education centres,
 - school pupils, whose parents are resident in Moray or Nairn,
 - Moray or Nairn schools and further education centres, and
 - clubs and organisations operating for the benefit of persons belonging to the former combined County of Moray and NairnIn making grants for any purpose, financial circumstances will be taken into account.
3. The closing date for applications each year will be 30 September.
4. Details of purposes for which grants may be made under the various sections of the Trust Scheme:-

Section 3: Annual Student Grants

Grants for post-graduate, further education or higher education courses (including Open University).

Section 4: Adult Education

Expenditure may be incurred in making grants in connection with the organisation of lectures or other suitable forms types of instruction for the promotion and encouragement of adult education in the former combined County of Moray and Nairn.

Section 5: Special Equipment

Grants may be made to schools in the former combined County of Moray and Nairn to assist in providing special equipment in supplement to that which the Education Authority might reasonably be expected to supply.

Section 6: Sports Facilities

Grants may be made to assist in providing and maintaining playing fields and other sports facilities for the benefit of children and young people resident in the former combined County of Moray and Nairn.

Section 7a: School Excursions – Grants to Schools

Grants to schools in the former combined County of Moray and Nairn to undertake educational excursions.

Section 7b: School Excursions – Grants to Individuals

Grants for an individual young person (school age) to enable participation in organised educational excursions.
