Grass Cutting

This doesn't seem to be happening enough. This is especially problematic at the playing fields for the football teams that play there.

Car Parking

There was a reply from Sergent Sean Jones from Police Scotland, he has spoken to the car owner who has said they will park elsewhere.

Community Garden

If anyone wishes to help with weeding they are more than welccome. Hilary is still fundraising for the Polytunnel. The Gig in the Garden was a great success and made £550.

Masonhough Road

A request was made for a sign to warn of Children playing. A sign saying that it is a traffic calming area. Due to regulations they are unable to incorporate child at play.

Youth Club Account

Les has been trying to get in touch with the Youth leaders regarding the use of this as the money had not been transferred yet. Moray Council has closed the account as they were closing unused accounts (the reason for Les and Billy opening an account). Although they know how much was in the account but not where it is but this will be sorted very quickly.

Pier Shed

There has been complaints about the rickety shed at the Harbour. Les took some photos as requested to Alec Burrel. He came down to look at it and he thought it looked worse than the photos sent. The tennants have come back and said that they are hiring contractors to take it down. It was agreed that it has gotten worse in the last couple of weeks.

Community Emails

Community Wardens

It was noted that there seems to be less presence than before. James informed us that the Wardens are down in numbers but have to cover large areas. It was noted the great work that they do.

Although noted that people tend to put their bins to one side they are not put back this way which does block access. Billy will get in touch with the council regarding this

Community Defibrillators

There has been lots of talk about defibrillators for community use. There is one at the Scot-mid shop in Burghead. There are a number in Lossiemouth which the community raised funds for. Rosie mentioned that there was one outside the Hopeman surgery. Kelly will speak to the Surgery and see how this was set up. The community ones are in vandal proof boxes and when calling an ambulance they will inform patients of where there nearest box is with a number to get into the box.

Lossiemouth High School plans

The plans for the proposed new high school were looked at and discussed. The plans are currently up in the High School this week and will be in the community centre from next week.

Community Council Re-election

This will be discussed next meeting who will be staying for another term. It was agreed that our break for the summer will be in August.
