Moray Local Government Councillors

Moray Councillors provide an important link between Community Councils and Moray Council. All Moray Councillors are ex officio Members of their local Community Councils and attend meetings on a regular basis. This allows them to gauge community opinion on a wide range of matters as well as helping Community Councils realise local projects and aspirations and liaising with services to resolve issues such as broken drains, potholes etc.

Building a good working relationship between Community Council and Councillor is important, if all are to gain from the expertise, experience and knowledge which each can bring to the table.

It is important to say, however, that at the end of the day, while your Councillor will take cognisance of the views of the Community Council, they cannot be bound by them and require to take all factors into consideration in reaching decisions.
