Police Update

Sgt T. Clarke gave us an update on local policing issues

Two males in possession of cannabis and Zanex. Another male found with quantity of Ketamine and reported for supplying offences.

Attemted robbery in Carnie Place

Vandalism – 3 reports

Aquisitive Crime- - theft of bank card, theft of lobster and crabs from fishing boat, Breaking into garage, attempting to break into car

Road Safety- Car Seized by police – 25 year old- no insurance and under the influence of alcohol

Following complaints regarding parking issues in Buckie officers are stepping up patrols and 5 people issued with parking tickets to date

Rat and pigeon issue in Buckpool harbour vicinity has been looked at. Moray Council have been down and can deal with vermin problem but local residences would have to share costs for this service.

Notices to be placed to deter feeding of seagulls which can only increase this problem.

Concern regarding state of repair of a building in Main Street- Loose slates, guttering which could cause serious injury to passers –by. Contact owner to try and address situation

Footbridge at Portessie – Anti – slip paint has now been applied.

Concerns regarding litter left on foreshore by recent travellers'. This was looked at by K. McKay. Two bags of litter had been left and seagulls had ripped one open. Dealt with

K. McKay would like to attend Buckpool Muirton Group meetings to see if there was anything we as the Community Council could assist them with and offer our support. This was agreed by all.

Defibrillator for Buckie - Where is the best place to site machine?

Need to get list of all machines in Buckie area and post the locations on our home page so that people know where they are.

A. Durno asked about transport for elderly and disabled after BABS has stopped. There does not seem to be a viable alternative.
