Post Aim:

 To build on the capacity, confidence and resources of the universal workforce to recognise and respond to the mental health and wellbeing needs of children and young people.

Post Remit:

- To provide mental health training to all staff working with children and young people – both general mental health awareness and training on specific mental health related concerns.
- To develop awareness of resources and services available to support children and young people with their mental health and to communicate the role of specialist mental health services.
- To build capacity through supporting mental health initiatives in the community
- Working in partnership with other health and social care professionals whose remit is to support children and young people's mental health, such as the practitioners within the Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service, Primary Care Clinicians, Educational Psychologists, School Nurses, Educational Staff and the Third Sector.
