## 4 Botriphnie/Drummuir

Work is currently being undertaken on the Gulley road to improve it. A workman has reported that one source of the run off constantly running off down the road is sewerage coming from the bank below the school and two houses. There is another unidentified source from further up the road.

Drummuir 21 held a successful St Fumac's Fair on 12th May in the sunshine. Approximately 100 people from 6 months old upwards enjoyed learning more about the Community Woodland, listening to stories of St Fumac and to poems about people and place. Earthtime were there and set out trails in the woodland and collected views and ideas that Botriphnie Primary School hope to begin to work on.

All Abilities Trail - CR Construction completed the resurfacing of the trail to the Westerton Crossroads, thanks to funding from Hill of Towie Windfarm Fund. It is now much better underfoot. Drummuir 21 is in contact with the Moray Council to arrange regular strimming to reduce encroachment.

It is hoped to get the bike ride up and running again which is due to take place in August 2018.

Cllr Louise Laing has been asked to find out if there is a weight limit on Rothiemay bridge, if not can one be put on? It was also put forward that some lights should perhaps be placed on the bridge.
