1 Opening of meeting:

Stewart opened the meeting and welcomed all present. The purpose of the meeting was to decide whether CDCC should adopt a revised Clause 17 of the CDCC constitution.

2 Apologies

There were no apologies.

3 Discussion

Adopting a revised Clause 17 would enable CDCC to lease property. This was particularly relevant at the moment because of the decision by Moray Council (MC) to close 2 of the 3 public toilets in the town. There was currently a huge demand from the public for the toilets in the Square and the Links to be open, particularly so because of the holiday season. A group had recently been formed in Cullen with a view to taking over the running of these toilets but, in the meantime, if CDCC were able to lease property, they could lease these toilets from MC until the other group was in operation.

The motion to adopt the revised Clause 17 was proposed by Steve, seconded by Phil and was there was a unanimous vote in favour.
