	a. In Feb/March had opportunity to make a bid to Sustrans to do feasibility work	
	in Forres for 20 mph/paths/Cycle Paths. Sustrans have therefore given the	
	funding for this. Spoken with the Green Spaces Group and other organisations.	
	Discussed with consultant who has viewed plans and to assess estimated costs	
	and if there are any gaps. This should give a working document to get back to	
	Sustrans and will take a couple of weeks. Once report is finished early	
	February next year bids will be submitted.	
	b. Electric Charging points for vehicles: Mr Major's team has been doing some	
	work on this with Moray Car Share. Transport Scotland also involved with	
	funding for installing electric chargers in Forres. Installation of a rapid	
	charger to service a trial electric wide bus. Route would be Forres to Aberlour	
	to test. Grant Park is earmarked as power supply is available at this point.	
	Rapid charger for cars earmarked for two locations Orchard Rd car park and	
	second site still to be considered.
