The Data Controller of the information being collected is Moray Council.

This privacy statement relates to the following process:

Community Care referral.

Your information is being collected to use for the following purposes:

Request for service assessment.

The legal basis/bases for collecting the information is:

Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject (this is you) is part or in order to take steps at your request prior to entering into a contract.

Where sensitive/ special category data is being processed (e.g. data concerning health information, criminal convictions etc.) the legal basis/bases for collecting the information is:

Processing is necessary for carrying out obligations under employment, social security or social protection law, or a collective agreement.

If you were to withhold the personal information we require for this process, the consequences would be:

The assessment could not take place and this could place the tenant at risk.

Your information will be shared with the following recipients or categories of recipient:

Moray Council Community Care Access team.

The personal data being used for this process includes:

Name, age, home address, home phone number, mobile number, date of birth.

Please note that you have the following rights:

- to object to any processing undertaken for the purposes of scientific/historical research and statistics, as so far as the legislation permits
- to object to the processing activity
