11 Boharm/Mulben

The public firework display held annually at Mains of Mulben, due to take place on 4th November 2018, was cancelled due to the cost of the public entertainment licence.

Volunteer drivers are needed to drive the community bus - the volunteers require to have a special licence to be able to drive it.

The play equipment in the playing field is not being looked after by the Council. After some discussion it was ascertained that the playing field and its equipment is not owned by the Council, therefore they would not look after it.
