Moray Services for Children and Young People supporting mental health

Concerned about a child or young person's mental health? What to do first...

Firstly, in many cases, it is helpful to discuss your concerns with the **General Practitioner** (GP), who may be able to provide information and advise about further support available.

In addition, you should contact the **Named Person** who is a professional available to listen, advise and help a child or young person and their parent/carer(s) by providing support and/or helping them to access other support services. The named person usually is:

- 0-5 years: Health Visitor
- Primary School: Head Teacher or Depute Head Teacher
- Secondary School: Guidance Teacher
- 16-18 not in education: Opportunities for All Officer

Professionals that can support a child or young person's wellbeing are as follows:

- School Nurse
- Home School Link Worker
- Youth Worker
- Inclusion Worker
- College Guidance Teacher

If a child or young person's needs cannot be met fully by those noted above, additional support services and targeted interventions are available.
