Botriphnie PGD & Drummuir JM – Botriphnie and Drummuir Matters.

Bridge over the River Isla: Priscilla Gordon-Duff reported that the damaged bridge at the bottom of the gulley road awaits repair. Temporary barriers are in place. PGD queried whether it might be possible to erect safety barriers in front of the bridge once the repair has been undertaken. Cllr Gatt offered to investigate. PGD to forward photographs to Cllr Gatt.

Drummuir All Abilities Trail: Following the repair and upgrade of the Trail, funded by the Hill of Towie Windfarm Community Fund, the Isla burst its banks in March causing significant damage to a stretch of the trail. Drummuir 21, SC030342, is investigating ways of undertaking and funding the repair.

Drummuir Station: Drummuir 21 was pleased to receive funding from the Hill of Towie Windfarm Community Fund to erect a shelter over the Storyteller Chair and benches. Work on the shelter is in progress, undertaken by a team from Loch Park Rural Skills Centre.

Botriphnie Primary School: For the past two terms groups of pupils...Eco Warriors... have undertaken activities in the Community Woodland, facilitated by a representative of Drummuir 21. Activities have included litter picking and planting a hedge of native berry trees. The plants were provided by The Woodland Trust. The Moray Council Ranger has also led a session on wildlife.
