1	<p>In the absence of the Chair, it was agreed that Mr Mackie would take the Chair.</p> <p><b>Apologies</b></p> <p>As noted above.</p>	
2	<p><b>Community Safety Partnership Report</b></p> <p>No Community Safety Partnership Report had been received.</p>	
3	<p><b>Moray Councillors' Report</b></p> <p>Cllr Morrison reported on the Council's Policy and Resources Committee.</p> <p>Matters under discussion included a Modernisation Programme, Digital Modernisation, Leisure Review – which will be completed shortly (with an emphasis on the role leisure and sport can play in prevention of poor health), a Management Review and Council Committees restructuring.</p> <p>A discussion ensued on the cuts announced to the Council budget including public toilets, grass cutting (Housing Revenue budget now covering the cost of cutting the grass in social housing areas), and school crossing patrols. 4	<p><b>Minutes of the Previous Meeting</b></p> <p>The minutes of the meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> May 2019 were agreed as a correct record. Proposed by Mr Mrs A Speake and seconded by Mr C Dunbar.</p>	
5	<p><b>Matters Arising</b></p> <p>THE BELTS – No response had been received from Moray Council in respect of the flooding. Cllr Morrison agreed to chase a reply.</p>	Cllr SM
6	<p><b>Treasurer's Report</b></p> <p>The Treasurer reported that there was no further update since his last report.</p>	
7	<p><b>Data Protection</b></p> <p>The Treasurer advised that Innes Community Council's data protection registration.</p>	
8	<p><b>Planning</b></p> <p>MARCHFIELD – On going.</p> <p>LAICHHILL – Planning consent had been granted. Mr Mackie reported that complaints had been received about the smell and dust which were causing health problems. Concerns were expressed that the extraction scheme was not working properly.</p> <p>STYNIE ROAD, MOSSTODLOCH – An application had been submitted to provide affordable housing on this site.</p> <p>EASTFIELD HOUSE, GARMOUTH – The Council had looked at this property back in February. Concerns were expressed over the safety of the site since the garage had collapsed. It was agreed that Mr Mackie would take this matter up with the Council.</p> <p>PARK ROAD, LHANBRYDE – The Secretary updated the meeting on the position with the old shop in this location. The site is now up for auction.</p> <p>TENNANT ARMS, LHANBRYDE – It was reported that Building Standards were visiting this site regularly to ensure enforcement of the planning conditions made at the time of approval.</p>	JM
