- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 12 December 2019.
- 6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 234 High Street, Elgin, IV30 1BA **by 12 midnight on Tuesday 26 November 2019**. Online applications to register can be made at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
- 7. Applications for new postal votes and amendments or cancellations of existing absent voting arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address **by 5pm on Tuesday 26 November 2019**. Completed application forms can be sent by email to elgin@grampian-vib.gov.uk
- 8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address by 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019. Completed application forms can be sent by email to elgin@grampian-vjb.gov.uk
- 9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address by 5pm on Thursday 12 December 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
