


BUILDING STANDARDS

COVID-19 UPDATE



The Building Standards team have been working hard to progress building warrant applications and retain business continuity throughout this period. However it is clear that during this unprecedented time that service delivery will change.

Our resources are not at full capacity and our ability to deliver a full service is not possible during this time. This will be particularly noticeable in terms of our administration support and our ability to carry out inspections.

We have already had to make the following changes to our service. These are summarised below:

- No face to face meetings are being carried out. We are happy to communicate by email and telephone.
- Use <u>eBuildingstandards.Scot</u> to submit your applications and revised plans.
- No intermediate or completion certificate inspections will be carried out. The only inspections which the service will carry out during this period will relate to a building which is immediately dangerous.
- In line with Scottish Government guidance we may consider intermediate and completion certificate submissions using alternative evidence. Please contact your building standards officer for further guidance.
- The issuing of documentation will be delayed at this time.

Please note the above is continually being reviewed in terms of both Scottish Government and Moray Council guidance.

Thank you for working with us during this period to maintain the building standards service.


