7. **Matters arising from previous minutes**
 - A. **PGD – UPDATE regarding Bridge at River Isla**

Damaged bridge over River Isla at Drummuir Station. PGD has contacted a company that undertakes Land Registry research. The fee is a minimum of £420 with no guarantee of success. She has also spoken with the Chairman of Keith Dufftown Railway who pointed out that TMC (The Moray Council) has repaired the bridge a number of times before. PGD requested that Cllr Coull might enquire whether TMC would be willing, without prejudice, to act as the 'manager' of the repair. This would entail dealing with the insurance company of the owner of the car that unfortunately slid into the bridge. Cllr Coull will make enquiry.
