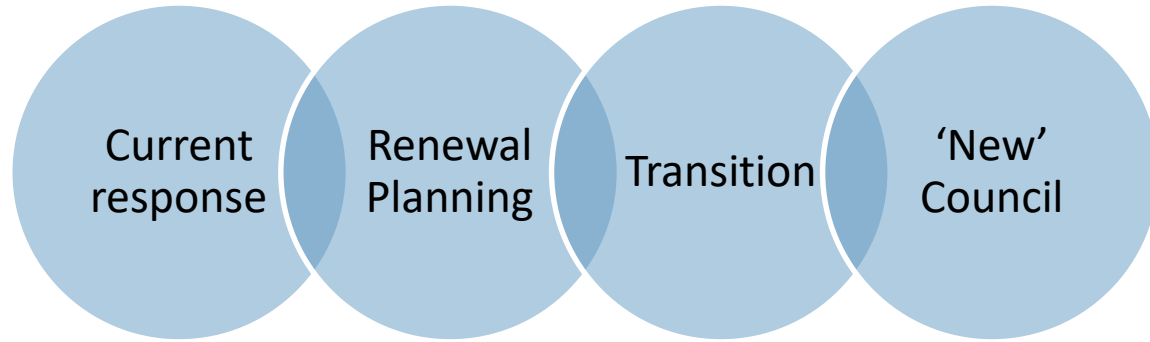

The Recovery Framework

The vision:

- strong, agile and inclusive recovery
- Flexing and innovating to regenerate the area
- New Moray more resilient with the council primed to deliver its priorities

The objectives:

- Prioritise those most affected
 - Support the vulnerable
 - Learn from our experiences so we emerge stronger
 - Stabilise our economy so it can grow
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The Recovery Action Plan

- Economic – high level action plan for local response developed through Moray Economic Partnership - £3.84m council investment proposed
- Educational – nationally directed; looking at lost learning, digital inclusion, the attainment gap, future exam diets, ongoing resilience
- Social – National direction on housing, welfare support, support for the vulnerable and abused; local plans informed by engagement responses
- Health – NHS Grampian and Moray Integration Joint Board

The Recovery Programme

- Stage 1 – March-May 2020 - Emergency response to first peak
- Stage 2 – Short term: June - December 2020
 - Recover services; test Recovery Framework; investigate to understand impacts; create prioritised action plans
- Stage 3 – Medium Term: January 2021- December 2022
 - Deliver actions but keep under review; begin re-engineering of strategies for new normal
- Stage 4 – Long term – post 2022
