### **DECISION NOTICE**

Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997
Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order and Trees in Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Regulations 2010

Notification of Works to Trees within Keith (Mid Street) Conservation Area

Removal of 1 x Scots Pine, 1x Cherry [Dead] and 2 x Cypress at 123a Mid Street, Keith

With reference to the notification of works to trees within a Conservation Area received on 03 June 2021, Moray Council has decided **NOT TO SERVE** a Tree Preservation Order (TPO) in relation to the above trees.

In accordance with Section 25 of the Act and <u>Policy EP7</u> Forestry, Woodlands and Trees of the Moray Local Development Plan (MLDP) 2020, Moray Council hereby **GRANTS** permission for the removal of the above trees on the basis that they are dead, dying or dangerous.

The works proposed can therefore proceed as described in the application and accompanying plan(s), subject to the conditions below.

#### CONDITIONS:-

1. The work(s) shall be carried out in accordance with British Standard BS:3998:2010 by a fully certified and insured arborist.

Reason: To safeguard the health and condition of trees.

2. The work(s) shall not damage other trees in close proximity, leading to a loss of amenity value.

Reason: To safeguard the health and condition of trees in close proximity.

3. Consent is valid for 2 years from the date of this notice.

Reason: To enable the Planning Authority to have regard to future amenity.

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997 AS AMENDED

# Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order and Trees in Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Regulation 2010

If the Applicant is aggrieved by the decision of the Planning Authority to refuse permission for tree work, or to grant permission subject to conditions, the Applicant may appeal to Scottish Ministers under Section 47 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997, as adapted and modified, within three (3) months from the date of this notice.
