# **DECISION NOTICE**

#### Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order and Trees in Conservation Areas (Scotland) Regulations 2010

Application for Works to Trees Protected by Drybridge Tree Preservation Order (TPO)

Removal of 2 x Beech (Fagus sylvatica [T862 and T863]) and reduction of 1 x Beech (Fagus sylvatica [T861]) crown on north side by up to 3m at Linnburn House, Drybridge

With reference to the application for works to trees received on 21 April 2020, The Moray Council hereby GRANTS permission for the above work(s) as described in the application and accompanying plan(s), subject to conditions attached to this consent.

### CONDITIONS:-

1. The work(s) shall be carried out in accordance with British Standard BS:3998:2010 by a fully certified and insured arborist.

Reason: To safeguard the health and condition of trees.

2. The work(s) shall not damage other trees in close proximity, leading to a loss of amenity value.

Reason: To safeguard the health and condition of trees in close proximity.

3. 2 replacement tree(s) (ratio 1:1) shall be planted during the planting season immediately following the tree works. Details of the siting, species and height (at the time of planting) of replacement trees shall be submitted to and agreed in writing by the Planning Authority prior to planting.

Reason: To maintain the amenity value protected by Drybridge TPO.

4. Consent is valid for 2 years from the date of this notice.

Reason: To enable the Planning Authority to have regard to future amenity.

#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997 AS AMENDED

#### Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order and Trees in Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Regulation 2010

If the Applicant is aggrieved by the decision of the Planning Authority to refuse permission for tree work, or to grant permission subject to conditions, the Applicant may appeal to Scottish Ministers under Section 47 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997, as adapted and modified, within three (3) months from the date of this notice.
