Camper Van Facilities

Following concerns raised in public comments, the Community Council has decided to accept Moray Council's offer to resurface the road from the Station Garage to the southwestern end of Park Street and also to have the track, from there, to the Caravan Site, filled and levelled. No action with the grass below the Salmon Green will take place and "no overnight parking" signs are to be erected. The waste disposal point will be by the public toilets, at the Harbour and work is expected to start in September.

Burghead & Hopeman Medical Surgeries

Evidence is building that both Burghead and Hopeman Surgeries are <u>not</u> to reopen following their closure due to Covid regulations. It is being stated that the current facilities are "not fit for purpose" and that "other options are being investigated."

The Community Council has not yet been officially informed but find these suggestions highly unacceptable, particularly for residents without their own transport. It is expected that a "consultation" will be held prior to a final decision and everyone is strongly encouraged to participate.

Local Resilience Plan

A team of Community Councillors and representatives from other agencies have been preparing draft resilience plans which would eventually be delivered to every household. The booklet would contain emergency contacts and advice on actions to take in the event of certain emergencies. An Open Day is to be held, in Elgin Town Hall on 26 March, next year.

Covid

With the Covid restriction eventually winding down, the Community Council is advising residents to remove any Covid status posters from their windows. We are most grateful to everyone who played a part in the response and anyone who still is in need of assistance, in any form, is welcome to contact us if they get less than acceptable results from the statutory agencies.

Community Council Elections – October 2021

This term of the Community Council is coming to an end and finishes on 3 October 2021 when it will be dissolved. Several Members are standing down, for various reason, some after many years of service.

Burghead has 8 Councillor and Cummingston 2. If these numbers are not exceeded, then applicants are elected, unopposed. If there were, say, 7 candidates from Burghead and 3 from Cummingston, they would all be elected.

If there are more applicants than seats then there is a postal ballot.

If you are interested in your community and want to be involved in making a difference, then this is the way to do it.

Thanks go to the departing Members and good wishes, for the future, to those who continue in post and to the new Members that join them.

More details will follow once the "Notice of Election" is published on 23 August 2021.
