**Note 2\*** These weights are where the materials have been collected individually on domestic runs due to operational reasons, but are from Domestic routes

**Note 3\*** HH mixed dry recyclables are blue and purple bins that are collected in twin track or 3 pod collection vehicles, however only one total tonnage weight is available for all the materials collected within the load (paper/card/cans/plastics/glass)

**Note 4\*** These are total tonnages sent to reprocessors and include materials that are from household collections, commercial collections, deposited by commercial customers; and from Household Waste Recycling centres, recycling points and unmanned recycling centres
