DECISION NOTICE

Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997

Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order and Trees in Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Regulations 2010

Notification of Works to Trees within Archiestown Conservation Area

Removal of 1 x Ash [T1] at The Square, High Street, Archiestown

With reference to the notification of work(s) to trees within a Conservation Area received on 20 September 2022, Moray Council has decided **NOT TO SERVE** a Tree Preservation Order (TPO) in relation to the above tree.

In accordance with Section 25 of the Act and [Policy EP7 Forestry, Woodlands and Trees](#) of the Moray Local Development Plan (MLDP) 2020, Moray Council hereby **GRANTS** permission for the removal of the Ash as the tree is dead, dying or dangerous.

The work(s) proposed can therefore proceed as described in the application and accompanying plan(s), subject to the informatives attached to this consent.

INFORMATIVES

1. The work(s) shall be carried out in accordance with BS:3998:2010 by a fully certified and insured arborist.

Reason: To safeguard the health and condition of trees.

2. The work(s) shall not damage other trees in close proximity, leading to a loss of amenity value.

Reason: To safeguard the health and condition of trees in close proximity.

3. 1 replacement tree, of a minimum 'Standard' specification, shall be planted during the planting season immediately following the completion of tree works. Details of the siting, species, height (at the time of planting) and protection measures of replacement tree shall be submitted to and agreed in writing by the Planning Authority prior to planting.

Reason: To maintain the amenity value protected by Archiestown Conservation Area.

4. Consent is valid for 2 years from the date of this notice.

Reason: To enable the Planning Authority to have regard to future amenity.

ADVISORY NOTES

The permission of the landowner(s) where the tree is located must be obtained prior to any tree works being undertaken.

Bats and their roosts, even when not in use, are protected under the Conservation (Natural Habitats) Regulations 1994 as European Protected Species. Prior to commencement of work(s), a survey for the presence of bats and their roost should be undertaken. If bats are found, a licence is required from [NatureScot](#) to carry out works to the tree(s).

All birds and their nests are protected under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. Prior to the commencement of work(s), a survey for the presence of nesting birds should be undertaken.
