Business:

- Community Speed Watch UK in response to the feedback from the survey on Aberlour News it was decided to register for membership.
 Some volunteers have been identified from this survey. MR to contact the police to see what advice and support they can offer the group to start a campaign.
- Managing major planning applications SCC has been inundated with major planning applications. There have been 5, so far, in the life of this CC. The previous CC, 2017-2021, dealt with 3 applications in 4 years, all of which were windfarms. This has serious implications regarding time constraints and lack of technical knowledge amongst the members. Dealing with planning

applications takes time away from other community activities that we wish to undertake.

It was decided to advertise for 'experts' from within the community for the different types of development being proposed. MR will raise this issue at the next JCC meeting.

MR will write to the Planning Department at Moray Council expressing our concerns regarding the industrialisation of Rothes together with the increase in vehicle movements that this will create
