Handheld thermo-hygrometer weekly readings

Museum Ground Floor (GF)	20.2°c	38%
Museum mezzanine	20.5°c	38.0%

12 mths ago High Life Highland Conservation Service recommended the heating was reduced to 18c. It is recommended to turn the museum temperature down to 18c, the day time temperature inside the museum is currently too warm for collections and when the building is not occupied.


Insects

There were some wood lice located on insect blunder traps, with dusty plaster and fras, indicting the left corner (the right corner, when looking on the outside of the museum opposite the entrance) has damp issues, also evident externally.

The tiny tag graph shows the exhibition cabinet is generally stable, however the fluctuations are not controlled within the cabinet.

The data is showing the cabinet is buffering the relative humidity outside the cabinet. Humidity cassettes are ordered and will be positioned in the cases in February, to stabilise the cabinets further.


The radiators in the stores have been turned up for the winter months, which will also help bring down the humidity.
