- Flooding Issues The recent closure of the road and issues
 with flooding on both sides of the village, DG (Counselor) has
 advised that both sides of the village on the A942 are on a
 "Reserve List" of works dependent on funds being available.
 Some remedial work will be done to clear blockages.
- Following our request that signs be erected on the track by Sustrans telling cyclists to be aware of, and to make themselves heard to warn other users on the track of their approach.
 Examples of signs and barriers have been passed onto Janet MacDonald at TMC. Janet has advised that she is in contact with Sustrans awaiting a reply.
- Harbour Toilets The sum of £5,000 has been awarded to the Paddling Pool Group, who maintain the facilities, from the Beatrice Field Fund by Visit Moray Speyside Tourism group. This is gratefully received many thanks to both organisations for this funding.
