Wider PEEP sessions are being reviewed as part of Moray Council contract with Action For Children. Performance monitoring continues across Primary and Secondary schools with universal and targeted visit programme to schools, supporting early intervention and actions for improvement. The service continues to be data led, collecting early indication data for Primary and Secondary in order to strengthen support and challenge visits and performance monitoring for in-year improvements. Scrutiny around wider contextual and pupil data continues in secondary, with additional funding including Attainment Scotland Funds, Strategic Equity Funding targeted following school approach for additional funding.	100%

Schools continue to review their curriculum offer and BGE curriculum, with further work planned for next sessions in relation to SCQF level 7 consortia working and BGE curriculum review. Meeting held with Sports and Culture Manager and Principal Active Schools and Community Sports Officer to highlight Physical Education, Physical Activity and Sport Framework. The Active Schools resources are in the process of being added to the framework and will support schools in developing quality PEPAS experiences for learners. Active Schools are keen to engage with the framework which aligns with their work. An English PT is working collaboratively with colleagues across the Northern Alliance to further develop the Moray Literacy and English Framework at Level 3-4. QIO has been invited to be part of the National Curriculum Improvement Cycle Collaboration Group for Interdisciplinary Learning next term. This information will be shared with Moray schools.	100%

This work will continue into term 4. The next meeting of the SLWG is at the start of term 4 with the aim of finalising and collating resources. There are now 9 Primary schools formally engaging with the Process of the Northern Alliance Learning, Teaching and Assessment Toolkit and one Secondary. More schools are engaging in the CLPL and resources links independently. On 20th March two Moray schools will share their approach to learner participation and ownership of learning which will be recorded and added to the Toolkit. The filming of good practice in Moray schools has started and this will be uploaded as a resource. The aim of the NA LTA Toolkit is to build a shared understanding of good practice and consistency of approach which aligns with Our Moray Standard for Learning and Teaching.	100%
