- 4. Entries must be emailed to **tenantparticipation@moray.gov.uk** with 'children's colouring competition' in the subject line, or by post to Housing and Property, PO Box 6760, Elgin, IV30 1BX.
- 5. We must receive your entry by no later than 31 March (winter colouring competition) or 31 October (summer colouring competition). Entries received after the deadline will not be accepted.
- 6. One winner will be selected at random after the closing date and their parents/carers notified by phone or email.
- 7. The decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 8. The winner will receive a £25 high street shopping voucher.
- 9. No cash alternatives will be offered, and prizes are non-transferrable.
- 10. Moray Council may wish to photograph the winner for promotional purposes. Parent/ carers permission will be sought. This may include the publication of your name and photograph in our Tenants' Voice newsletter, social media and website.
