



Moray Tenants Forum Logo Design Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. The competition is open to young people aged between 11 and 18 years who are members of a Moray Council tenant's household. Only one entry per young person will be accepted.
2. Parent/carer permission must be given with your entry along with their name and contact details. We will contact parent/carers of the winner after the competition closes. If we can't get hold of your parent/carer another winner will be chosen.
3. To enter, young people must design an original logo for Moray Tenants Forum either digitally or by hand. Your design must be your own original work and not made with the help of artificial intelligence (AI).
4. If we suspect your design is from a third party and not your own work, your entry will not be considered.
5. Entries should be submitted via www.moray.gov.uk/tenlogocomp or by post to: Logo Design Competition, Housing & Property, PO Box 6760, Elgin IV30 1BX.
6. We are unable to return entries.
7. Moray Council reserves the right to use any of the entries submitted to the competition for promotional purposes.
8. Copyright of an entry remains with the entrant, but they licence Moray Council to use images of their entry online and in print in perpetuity (forever).
9. The competition will close on 6 October 2025. Entries received after the closing date will not be accepted.
10. The winning design will be chosen by Moray Tenants Forum, and their decision will be final. Our graphic designer will use the winning design to create the new logo and branding for Moray Tenants Forum.
11. The winner will be notified by email or phone within the month of November 2025.
12. The winner will receive a £25 high street shopping voucher.
13. Moray Council reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal value if this is necessary for reasons beyond its control.
14. No cash alternatives will be offered, and prizes are non-transferrable.
15. Moray Council may wish to photograph the winner and their logo for promotional purposes. Parent/ carers permission will be sought. This may include the publication of your name and photograph in our Tenants' Voice
