(VARIOUS DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES – MORAY) ORDER 2025



Moray Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The effect of the Order will be to make existing advisory disabled parking places on various streets and at some public buildings in Moray legally enforceable. This will enable Moray Council to fulfil its statutory obligations, under the Disabled Persons' Parking Places (Scotland) Act 2009, to assess all existing advisory on-street disabled parking spaces to determine whether they are required and to promote a Traffic Regulation Order to cover each such parking place.
