I'm aware that there are differing definitions of 'complex' home care across local authorities but that the council may categorise a care package as 'complex' based on:

- 1. Number of Hours: Some authorities may define complex home care based on the number of hours of care needed per week or per day. For instance, if a person requires a significant amount of care each day, involving multiple interventions and skilled nursing, it may be considered complex home care.
- 2. Health Conditions: The presence of certain health conditions or combinations of conditions may also define complex home care. This could include chronic illnesses, severe disabilities, or a combination of physical and mental health needs that require ongoing support and monitoring.
- 3. Interventions and Procedures: Complex home care may involve the need for specialized procedures, medication management, wound care, monitoring of vital signs, or other skilled nursing tasks that go beyond basic home assistance.
- 4. Functional Limitations: Individuals with significant functional limitations, such as those who are bedridden, wheelchair-bound, or have limited mobility, may require complex home care due to the level of assistance needed for daily activities and health maintenance.
- 5. Risk Factors: Local authorities may also consider factors such as the risk of complications, hospital readmissions, or the need for emergency interventions when defining complex home care. Individuals with complex medical needs that require close monitoring to prevent health crises may fall into this category.

If you can't make a classification using the above list generally I would be looking for anything above 100 hours per week.
