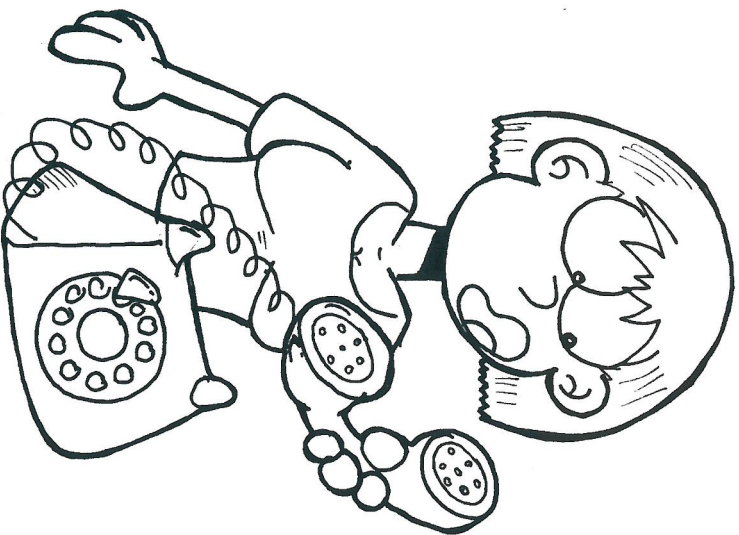

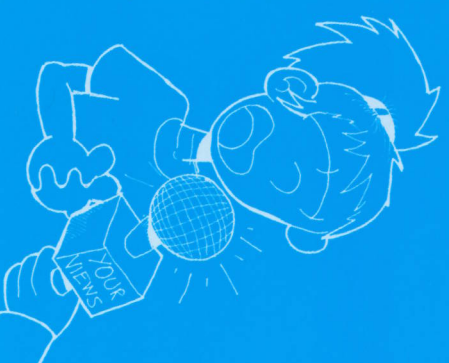

Sometimes it can be difficult to speak up in a room full of adults who are speaking about you! I think it is important that you go to these meetings and I can come along with you to support you. I can also go to the meeting for you if you really don't want to go.

I can help you prepare for meetings such as Children's Hearings or any other meetings in school or elsewhere which are about you.

I can help you if you want to appeal against a change in your Educational Maintenance Allowance or your exclusion from school.

I can help you to speak up if you think something that is happening in your life is wrong or unfair.

The service is confidential and you should never get into trouble for getting in touch.
