The Moray Council's Aftercare Service provides support to young people aged 16+ who have been in foster or residential care, with a view to their moving successfully from the care system and onto independence.

What are Supported Lodgings

The Supported Lodgings Scheme aims to provide young people with the opportunity to move out of care into a supportive environment, in preparation for moving onto independent living.

Accommodation would be offered for varying periods of time, dependent on the young person's needs and progress.

During these placements both the provider and the young person will continue to be supported by workers from the Moray Aftercare Service.
