



The Gambling Act 2005

Notice to the Moray Licensing Board of an intention to make 1 or 2 gaming machines available under section 282 of the Gambling Act 2005

This form is made available by the Moray Licensing Board in accordance with section 282(2) of the Gambling Act 2005 ("the Act") to those premises that wish to register for an automatic entitlement to provide gambling facilities in the form 1 or 2 gaming machines of category C or D only.

Section 278(1) of the Act applies section 282 only to those premises in respect of which an on-premises alcohol licence has effect AND which contain a bar at which alcohol is served for consumption on the premises (without a requirement that alcohol is served only with food).
