Objectives

- To curtail further growth of the village
- To maintain the character and features of the original village area
- To consider designation of the old part of the village as a Conservation Area.

Water and Drainage

There is adequate capacity but it is essential that developers should contact Scottish Water at an early stage. Foul drainage must be connected to the public sewer.

Roads

All comments on road infrastructure requirements are intended to be of assistance to developers and advise them generally of improvements that are likely to be needed in order to service the site. These requirements are not exhaustive and do not pre-empt anything that might result from a Transport Assessment.

Environment

Parts of Duffus lie within aircraft noise contours published by the Ministry of Defence. Developments within such areas will be subject to consultation with MoD, and consideration against policy EP7 regarding noise pollution.
