Any Other Business

New Play Area planned for Findochty Caravan Park

The Community Council are unaware of these plans. Councillor Anne McKay to investigate proposed plans with regard to this as Mr and Mrs Main are concerned that a more elaborate play facility could attract unruly local youths particularly over the summer months.
