Matters Arising from Previous month's meeting

- **Play Area at Findochty Primary School** – Colin Thain and Leslie Loades stated their concern over the fact that the “high risk” play equipment at the school has yet to be removed, in particular the nets which were deemed unsafe. Councillor Anne McKay asked the Council to allow them the time agreed, ie the equipment is to be removed during the school holidays, before taking the matter further.
- **Faulty Boiler in the Town Hall** – Colin advised that this has been passed to Tracey Rae but no response to date.

Any Other Business

Discussion over the Pilot scheme

The Council have agreed to apply for the funding to be used to increase interest in the Community Council. Several ideas were put forward and to be discussed further at next month's meeting.

Cycle path

Reports of the cycle path being overgrown have been passed to the Council. Councillor Anne McKay advised she has spoken with the relevant department regarding this issue.

The Plinth

Leslie raised the matter of the newly erected plinth at the Slip beach and how we can raise funds to have it completed as planned, with the history of the Slip and photos for visitors to view. She proposed that we could approach local businesses to advertise around the display. Councillor Gordon McDonald suggested we approach the Leader Fund to ask for funding.
