3. Matters Arising

2 Haig Street – The lady and family have moved away and the man is now back staying in the house. We will keep our eye on this.

Library – Has now moved and the official opening will be held on Thursday, 8th October. The new computers have still to be installed and this will be monitored.

Cllr Shepherd has spoken with the relevant department at the council and has been advised that the tenants in Samson Place and Craigview Road stay in the properties. The council are to check on the tenants utility bills.

4. Police Matters – PC Mairi Page advised that there had been some complaints from Neighbourhood Watch and Alan regarding the skate boarding. This was discussed and it was suggested that the Police advise the children that they may use the road down to the Bow Fiddle Rock at the end of Admiralty Street as this should not cause a nuisance to anyone. The horsebox at the top of Admiralty Street has been moved and the owner of the horsebox was most distressed to think that she had caused any inconvenience to anyone. PC Page advised that there had been some problems with underage drinking in the school shelter.
