3.	<p><b>Matters Arising from minute 18-11-09</b></p> <p>4.2 Brodie Speed Limit – Letter sent to MC Roads requesting consideration of extending the 50mph zone - no response received to date – reminder to be sent.</p> <p>5. Info on how long Duncan McConnell had been a CC member still awaited from Archives Quaich purchased and to be engraved with inscription similar to Roddy Macleods.</p> <p>14.3 The area of ground has been identified and ownership will be established so that action can be taken to weed kill the area.</p> <p><b>Matters Arising from Minute of 17-02-2010</b></p> <p>10.2 Grit Bins Following further discussion it was agreed that the purchase of grit bins for local areas by the CC, despite good intentions, would be too complex to manage and the liability issues around supply, distribution and maintenance would place the Community Council in an unacceptable position.</p> <p>10.3 Street Maps Broom of Moy map is still outstanding as MG has not been able to source a map of the area in sufficient detail. IO agreed to obtain one from Planning. 4.	<p><b>Treasurers Report</b></p> <p>4.1 Balance of account remains the same as last month (£3245.87). Still processing the second signature with Lloyds TSB at which point cheques will be written to settle outstanding accounts. (Hall rental and donation to Noah's Ark Playgroup.)</p> <p>4.2 Given the Grit Bins idea seems problematic we agreed that all Community Councillors would canvas for and consider ideas for using existing funds for Community Benefit in our area and bring them to the next meeting.</p>	
5.	<p><b>Andy Jamieson, ASBO Co-ordinator Moray</b></p> <p>5.1 Andy was welcomed to the meeting and gave an outline of his and his team's remit.</p> <p>5.2 They sit within the Multi Disciplinary Community Planning Group and focus on Community Safety as one of the agreed Scottish Government</p>	<p><b>MG</b></p>

- Single Outcome Agreements of 'Safer Communities'. In broad terms criminal activities are addressed by the police and nuisance activities are dealt with by the ASB Team.
- 5.3 There are 4 themes, Anti Social Behaviour, Road Safety, Domestic Violence in the Home and Fire and Home Safety and Andy gave some examples of initiatives that address these themes.  
He also explained the process in obtaining an Anti Social Behaviour **Order** via a Sherriff and the steps necessary in advance of this extreme level of intervention. There are currently 15 ASBO's in operation across Moray.

- 5.5 The question was raised as to at what point one brings a matter to the attention of the team or the police and the response was as soon as it is apparent that the activity or issue is wrong.
- 5.6 This led to discussion about behaviour in and around Broom of Moy with people drinking and leaving the place littered with broken glass. **KS** agreed to provide a map so that zones could be defined to readily identify locations where unacceptable behaviour was taking place and the culprits apprehended.
- 5.7 At this point it was agreed to take the Grampian Police report and that this would be a formal Agenda item for future meetings.  
SJ noted the issues at Broom of Moy and gave out the Service Point number for contacting Police 0845 6005700. This is a central number in Aberdeen but call handlers should be expert enough to identify locations across Moray. **KS** agreed to provide a copy of the standard questions asked by call handlers for the CC. **KS**
- 5.8 **KS** also provided some more anti dog fouling posters for distribution
6. **Publicity Shot for Local Paper** **CMcL**

- 11.3 **MG** requested that Dyke Landward CC provide written confirmation of their support to Broom of Moy Flood Alleviation scheme. **CMcL** agreed to do this. **CMcL**
