## <u>Town and Country Planning (Schemes of Delegation and Local Review Procedure)</u> (Scotland) Regulations 2008

Request for Review: Planning Application 09/01611/PPP: Planning permission in principle for the erection of a dwellinghouse on a site adjacent to Roadside Croft, Grange, Keith Unaccompanied Site Inspection

At the meeting of the Moray Council Local Review Body (LRB) on 25 February 2010 it was agreed to undertake an unaccompanied site inspection. The purpose of the site inspection is to view the site in the context of Policy H8, in particular to the natural backdrop, prominence of the site and overall character of the area.

I would advise you that, in terms of Regulation 16 (2) of the 2008 Regulations, members of the LRB, the Clerk and the Legal and Planning Advisors propose to visit the site of the planning application, at approximately 11.35 am on Friday 19 March 2010.
