**Subject:** RE: Procedure issues

Dear All,

To those participating that the dates for submitting inquiry documents will be 19 October 2010 and precognitions 2 November 2010. The date for lodging core and hearing specific documents remains unchanged at 21 September 2010.

The Reporter agrees that it would be helpful if the council included a list of conditions, etc as a part of their hearing statement for the hearing session on conditions/legal agreements

The council are not required to submit an inquiry statement for the inquiry session on landscape and visual issues. The council should lodge their written submission as a document. It therefore requires to be submitted by the revised date for submitting inquiry documents, ie 19 October 2010, rather than 21 September 2010.

In relation to the further written submission procedures, the Reporter notes that the council are intending to rest on the information in their committee report which has already been lodged. The council are not obliged to make further written submissions. However, he believes that it would be helpful to the process being followed if they could make comments on those items where they have been requested to make a contribution (eg 3[h] of wildlife and habitat issues) or they have a valid contribution to make (eg 1 of wildlife and habitat issues).

They will also have the opportunity to respond to the submissions that other parties make.
