Proposed conditions and possible legal agreements

I apologise but I appear to have omitted responding to you in respect of the above issue.

I would like to make the following observation regarding the draft conditions/legal agreements provided by Moray Council on 27 August 2010.

Condition 17

In our view this is the key over-arching condition and the wording needs to be precise and clear as to the exact plans and statements it is referring to. In our opinion the use of 'etc.' and parenthesis is inappropriate and would suggest that the wording is tightened up and all plans that the HSEMS includes are listed.
