**Town and Country Planning (Schemes of Delegation and Local Review Procedure)
(Scotland) Regulations 2008**

**Request for Review: Planning Application 08/02487/FUL : Full planning permission to
renovate and reuse remains of existing Lime Kiln to create a dwellinghouse at Braehead
Quarry, Keith.**

At the meeting of the Moray Council Local Review Body (MLRB) on 22 September 2010 it was agreed to undertake an unaccompanied site inspection, the purpose of which being to view the site in the context of policies H7, H8, E10, EP9 and IMPI of the Moray Local Plan 2008.

I would advise you that, in terms of Regulation 16 (2) of the 2008 Regulations, members of the MLRB, the Clerk and the Planning Advisor propose to visit the site of the planning application, at approximately 3.50pm on Friday 8 October 2010.
