





## 1868 - Ordnance Survey Town Plan of Elgin

- 1 Ladyhill monument; 1939 and 1855, visible from much of the town and the surrounding area
- 2 South Street; now well established
- 3 Museum; 1843
- 4 Lossie Green first appears as recreational grounds
- 5 Boroughbriggs Road

- 1 High Street remains the through route for traffic until1981
- 2 North Street remains the primary route to the North
- Route of the planned A96 bypass and A941
- Elgin Town Hall; 1957-1961
- 5 Netherport Court housing; departing from the compact urban grain characteristic of the town
- 6 Industrial land use
