Blue Bin – all paper & card products



- Newspapers & magazines
- ✓ Phone books & yellow pages
- Cardboard boxes and packaging
- ✓ Tetra-Pak drinks cartons
- Envelopes (incl. Window envelopes)
- ✓ Letters & unwanted mail
- ✓ Scrap & shredded paper

- No Plastic bags
- × No Polystyrene
- × No Plastic bottles

Purple Bin – cans & plastic bottles



- Drinks cans
- Food cans & tins
- ✓ Foil food trays
- Clean tin foil
- Aerosols
- ✓ Clean yogurt & margarine tubs
- ✓ Metal bottle tops and jar lids
- ✓ Plastic bottles, types ♠ & ∠25

Orange Box – glass jars & bottles



Glass bottles & jars

- No Plastic bottles
- No Plastic bags
- No Pyrex
- No Mirror or window glass

Grey Kitchen Caddy – all food waste and scraps



- ✓ Raw & cooked meat, fish, bones
- ✓ Fruit & vegetables
- ✓ Bread, cakes & pastries
- ✓ Cheese, yogurt & eggs (incl.shells)
- ✓ Tea bags & coffee grounds
- ✓ Pet food
- ✓ Used kitchen roll

- No Plastic bags
- × No Foil or cling film
- × No Food or drinks cans
- × No Bottles, cans & jars
- No Packaging

If preferred, you can line your caddy with newspaper or a Compostable Bag. Please empty your caddy into the brown bin for servicing.

Brown Garden Bin – all organic garden & kitchen waste



- Grass cuttings
- ✓ Leaves & branches
- ✓ Plants & weeds
- ✓ Food waste
- ✓ Hedge trimmings
- ✓ All food waste

- × No Dog Poo
- × No Plastic
- No Root balls
- × No Rubble
- × No Soil
- × No Stones
- × No Turf
- × No Blocks of wood

Green Household Bin – all other waste that cannot be recycled



No Recyclables

Please make sure all waste is contained within the bin, with the lid closed. Please do not leave excess or side waste beside your bin as it will not be uplifted and could be burst open by birds and animals
