You can ask for the support of the worker at any time.

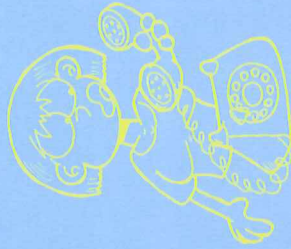

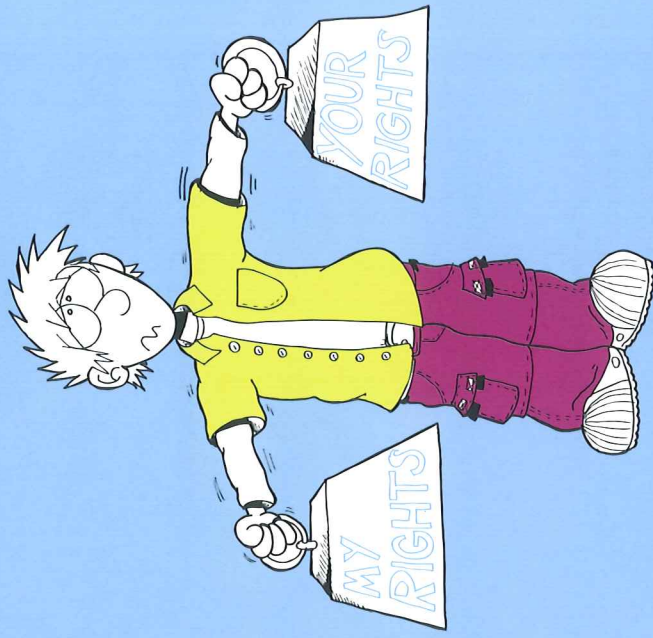

CHILDREN 1ST

THE CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE'S RIGHTS WORKER CAN SUPPORT YOU BY:

- giving you information about your rights
- supporting you to prepare for any meetings about you
- going to any meetings with you to support you to have your say
- supporting you to fill in forms or reports for meetings
- going to meetings for you if you don't want to go
- giving you advice and support to speak up if you have concerns about things which affect you or other children and young people
- supporting you to appeal if you have been excluded from school
- supporting you to appeal against a change in your Educational Maintenance Allowance

THE RULES

THE CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE'S RIGHTS WORKER WILL:

- listen to what you say and take you seriously
- tell you about the choices you could make so that you can think about them
- not try to change your mind
- help you to feel part of the meeting and to get your point of view across
- look after your rights
- Not share your thoughts with other people unless you say it is okay (except if a child might be in danger)
