<ul> <li>This service provides a pre-school education place for every 3 and 4 year old whose parents wish it. The authority has a duty to provide this.</li> <li>Pre-school education places are provided in 21 school nursery classes with additional places procured annually from the private, voluntary and independent sectors. Currently there are 34 partner providers of pre-school education.</li> <li>Places are currently commissioned at a rate of £1,600 per fully funded place i.e. 475 hours per year. (NB - This will increase to a minimum of 600 hours from 2014.)</li> <li>There were 2,148 funded places as of 28 June 2012.</li> <li>There were 2,148 funded places as of 28 June 2012.</li> <li>There is a national expectation that all pre-school children will have access to a fully qualified teacher. There is a central team of two teachers. (There is an additional teacher on secondment until end October 2012). One provides curriculum support and development/training opportunities. The other teacher supports providers in the early identification of children with additional support needs, referrals to appropriate agencies and devising individual education plans.</li> <li>Quality assurance of the delivery of Curriculum for Excellence is carried out by a quality improvement officer.</li> <li>In addition, quality assurance services regarding self-evaluation and improvement planning are procured annually. Currently these services are provided by the Care and Learning Alliance. At the moment this costs £39050 per year.</li> </ul>
